\$20,000 is the base total for this event's speaker. This includes all travel expenses and allows for 7 presentations. There will be additional expenses to make this as successful as possible with the greatest impact, for example, advertising and administrative expenses. There are no employees of our organization. All help is volunteer which allows all dollars raised to be used by So Much More to continue good works in the community.

If the total amount is not raised, will the speaking engagements be canceled?

No, the events will take place regardless of funds raised. "So Much More" will continue to work to bring this and future yearly events to the area. Because this is our first event and the start of our organization it has been difficult to know exactly what the support of the communities will look like. There are ways to support in addition to financial needs. There are groups giving their time, some their skills (for instance printing), some are helping with behind-the-scenes needs. We have grown to a core group of about 10 volunteers, and we are passionate about making a difference. We feel the financial support will come in many forms and are thankful for that support no matter the givers' ability. The phrase "It takes a village", is so very true.

Is it a free event for the schools and for the public to attend?

Absolutely. Our goal is to provide these opportunities without barriers. Various times and locations as well as no fees to the attendees or venues will be charged. Our goal is to reach as many people as possible with a positive message of hope.

Can you also share what other organizations have committed to sponsorship and at what dollar level?


