



By the 8th inning the scoreboard read like a cruel joke: 😶 **Reds 11, Twins 1** !!!


Maybe at next year's outing we can see the Twins win (or maybe we will all resort to watching Professional Bowling !)




- Any Mason from any Lodge may enter contest




