Finally, we are planning to have 2 community service activities such as working a food shelf or other service events in the St. Paul area around our Plato location.

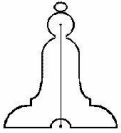
I am excited about 2026 and look forward to meeting and engaging with many more of you. See you out there, my Brothers!

Civility

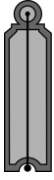
